The service can help with a wide range of issues

- if there is a breakdown of communication
- if there is a breakdown of trust
- if your child's needs are not being met
- if the school suggest a part-time timetable
- if the placement is at risk of breaking down
- if your child needs an assessment of their needs
- if there are behaviour management issues
- if your child has no school to go to
- if you need to know more about the schools and services in Newcastle
- if your child is excluded
- if your child's special educational needs haven't been recorded or shared
- if you don't understand the special educational needs procedures
- if you think there has been a breach of the equalities legislation in the treatment of your child.
- Local Authorities pay for the service and it is free for parents and carers to use.
- Parents choose whether or not to use the service – you contact us not the other way round.
- The service is confidential and impartial.
