Children will be learning to identify the body parts of the human anatomy and will be learning to work scientifically.

- Identify, name, draw and label the basic body parts of the human body

- Observe living things using simple equipment
- To identify and sort objects by their properties
- To collect and record data to help answer questions

Children will be learning about the country that they live in;

- Name and locate places of local interest
- Understand the meaning of country and capital
- Identify characteristics of the four countries that make up the UK and its surrounding seas
- Key human features: City, Town, Village, Factory, Farm, Houses, Offices, Port, Harbour and Shops.
- Use world maps to identify the UK and some oceans and seas
- Learn and understand local events that have occurred recently in the children's local area
- Understand 'Time' as a concept of things that happened in the past, present and future.
