Maths

Positional Language – Game using the positional language words

in, on, under, over, through, in front, behind, in-between, next to.

What is it? Game. Ask your child to find things around your house that are in, on, under, over, through, in front, behind, in between, next to something.

e.g Can you tell me what is in front of the sofa? Can you tell me what is above the TV? Etc etc

Phonics

*Watch Phonics with Maddison Phase 3 lesson 7 – ‘ z / zz’ sound on you tube. Please do sit with your child and encourage their understanding. Try the suggested activities again after the program has finished.

*Complete the ‘z’ pages in your phonics book 3.

* Get out your cvc word cards and practice blending the sounds to read the words. How fast can you now blend to read?

Practice writing your own full name and names of people in your house.

Positional Language game – Find the treasure game – The treasure can be chocolate, sweets, fruit, toys, anything your child will enjoy. Adult to hide 9/10 things around the room whilst child has eyes closed. (Try and hide them in places where your child needs to use all the positional language words **in, on, under, over, through, in front, behind, in-between, next to.**

Your child then goes off on a hunt to find the things you have hidden. If they can describe where (i.e. using the words above) then they can keep the treasure. Play the game again in a different room or take it in turns who hides the treasure.

Phonics

*Watch Phonics with Maddison Phase 3 lesson 8 - ‘qu’ sound on you tube. Try the suggested activities again after the program.

*Complete pages for letter sound ‘qu’ page in your phonics book 3.

*Practice segmenting to spell cvc words using your cvc picture cards.

Remember to draw your 3 boxes on your whiteboard (one for each sound in the words). How quick can you spell 3 letter words now?

Chinese New Year – Every year in school we learn all about this celebration and what chinese people do during this time. Today please watch the following story on twinklGo (website easy to find, you need to sign up but its free to use, no child log in needed) Scroll down to 'featured this week'. Click on 'Dragons in the city ebook with audio'. This story explains what chinese people do to celebrate.

See the photos on class dojo story and practice writing chinese numbers 1-10 with black paint and a brush or even just a felt pen or pencil.

Also on Twinkl Go website look for 'Chinese New Year Interactive colouring activities.' This gives children the opportunity to use a mouse or their finger and interact with a drawing package online using the colours and tools tabs.

Other ideas of activities, games and on line resources

Practice fine motor skills such as cutting independently with scissors, using a knife and fork, tying your shoe laces.

Play track board games together where children roll a dice and jump on that number of jumps.

Do jigsaws and puzzles.

Make some play dough together to play with, bake some biscuits or cakes. Use the rolling pin, spoons for mixing etc.
