Provide a safe and secure environment. Have clear rewards for good behaviour and sanctions for unacceptable behaviour.</p>	<p>Follow the Simonside golden rules: Be gentle, kind and helpful, listen, honest, work hard and look after property.</p>	<p>Encourage my child to behave appropriately in and out of school and follow the school rules. Behave respectfully towards all staff, other parents and pupils. Avoid using loud and unacceptable language on the school yard.</p>
<p>Attendance and Punctuality</p> <p>Article 28 (right to education)</p> <p>Every child has a right to an education</p>	<p>Check attendance and punctuality regularly and contact parents with any concerns. Support families when needed.</p>	<p>Attend school every day (except when I am not well) and arrive on time at 08.50. <i>Target: 97%</i></p>	<p>Ensure my child attends school regularly and on time. Let school know by 08.55 if my child is too unwell to attend school. Pick up my child promptly at the end of the school day.</p>
