Challenge 1: History

Watch the youtube clip above – ‘100 years of toys’.

Talk with a grown up how toys have changed over the years. You could even ring your gran or granddad to talk about what toys they liked to play with when they were in Year 1.

Challenge 2: Maths

With help from your parents, draw around your hands, cut them out and use them to practise number bonds to 10 until you know them off by heart.



If you know your bonds to 10, use four hands to practise number bonds to 20.

Challenge 3: Literacy

Draw a picture of your favourite toy.

Write a description about this toy.

What does it do?

What does it look like?

Why do you like to play with it?

What's your favourite thing to do with it?

Remember to make sure your child is using their phonic knowledge to spell words. This means even if the word is spelt incorrectly but your child has sounded the words out using the sounds they know.

Count out loud to 100.

Challenge 5: Science
