Hi everyone,

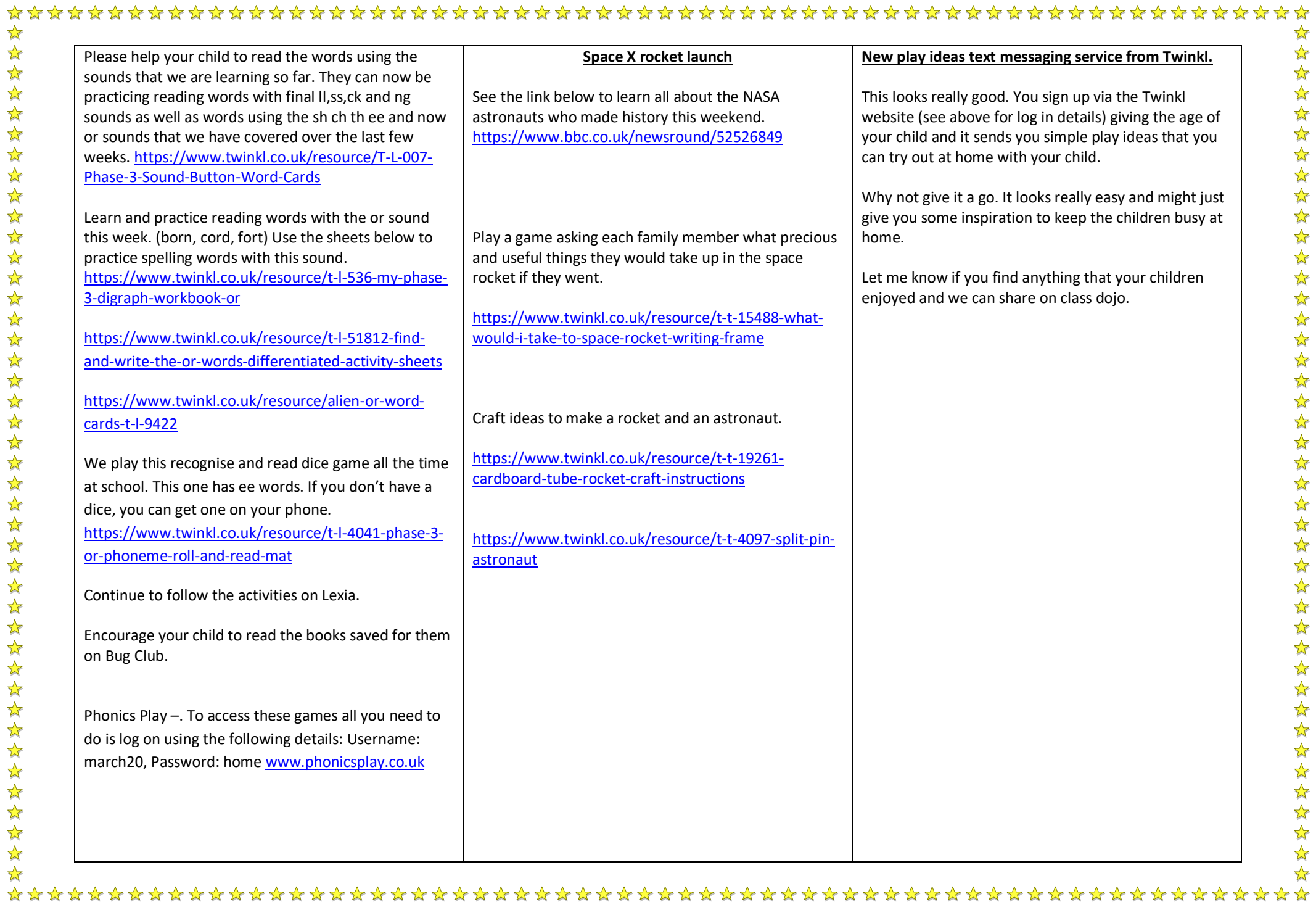

<u>Literacy – Reading, Writing and phonics</u>	<u>Maths</u>	<u>Knowledge and Understanding of the World</u>
<p>This week I will be reading you the story of 'Superworm'.</p> <p>At home you could:-</p> <p>Read the story together. (lots on you tube)</p> <p>Talk about what happened first, next, after that and at the end.</p> <p>Encourage your child to write short sentences to retell the story. Encourage them to sit writing on the line, use finger spaces between words, spell words themselves using the phonic sounds they can hear and to finish with a full stop. The activities are easy to do and don't need many resources just paper, pencils and maybe some playdough and paint.</p> <p>Please do let me know on class dojo if you like the format of these videos and we can do some more in the coming weeks.</p>	<p>We have something exciting to show you this week. Normally in school when we teach all about minibests, we send off to get some real caterpillars which come as part of a special 'Grow your own caterpillars' kit. The children observe the caterpillars growing and eating each day and change into their cocoons/chrysalis and then emerge as beautiful butterflies. The children simply love to watch this process evolve especially watching them fly away when we release them at the end of the process. Unfortunately because of Covid 19 we haven't been able to get the caterpillars until now.</p> <p>I have added Mrs Johnson to our class dojo and she will be updating you all each day about the caterpillars and showing you lots of pictures of them growing and changing.</p> <p>EXCITING EXCITING EXCITING times over the next 2 weeks.....</p>



Please help your child to read the words using the sounds that we are learning so far.
