Please go on a search around your house or garden and take photos of things that make you think about other things that we did in school this year.

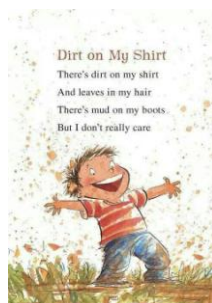
Challenge 3: All About Me
