Challenge 5

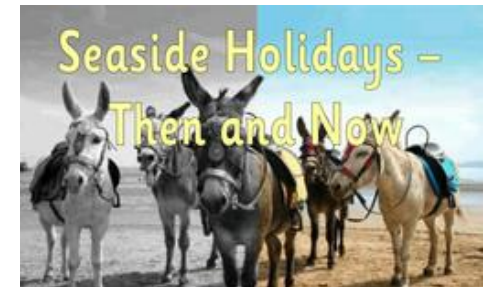
Watch this short clip called "Scrambled"
