Can you count backwards from 20?

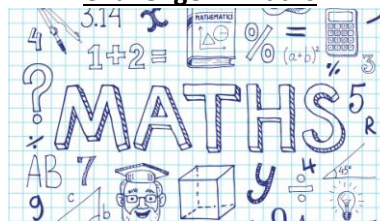
Can you count in 2s to 50?
