Topic: Colour Chaos!

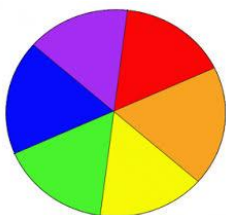
Your home learning is your choice! There are 9 challenges to choose from below. Please try and complete 6 challenges this week.

Challenge 1: Art

This week we are learning to mix primary colours to create a secondary colour.



Can you remember which colours are primary colours? Please mix primary colours of paint to create the secondary colours. (These are orange, green, and purple.)

If you don't have any paint at home, please use the colour orange to create a piece of artwork. This could be a picture, a collage or a sculpture.

Challenge 2: Science

This week we are learning to understand that some trees are evergreen and some are deciduous.



Go for a walk and look at leaves on trees. Look at how they are different shapes, sizes, colours and textures. Please listen to this short song about evergreen and deciduous trees:
