Topic: Comparison of France and the UK

Your homework is your choice! There are 9 challenges to choose from below. Please try and complete 6 challenges this week.

Challenge 1 (Literacy)

Look at the sentences below. Each one is missing inverted commas. Insert inverted commas around the direct speech in the sentences.

Challenge 2 (Art)

Challenge 3 (Maths) Card Challenge

There are seven different possibilities. Try to find them all.

Challenge 4 (Geography) Newcastle Tourism

Make a travel guide promoting where they should go, what they should do and what they could visit. Think back to the research we did on some important human and physical features of Newcastle.

Challenge 5 (Maths)

What number did Dan find?

The detective dog then found a two-digit odd number.

One of its digits was half the other. The number was greater than 50. What number did he find?
