






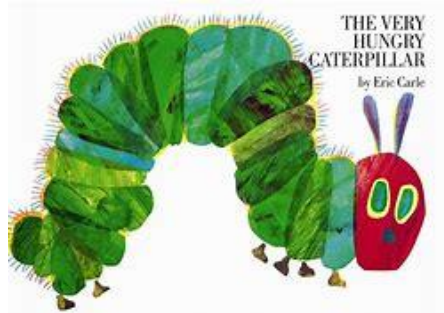
## Nursery's Remote Learning Plan- 01.3.21

	Something to <b>read</b> ...	Something to <b>make</b> ...	Something to <b>sing</b> ...	Something to <b>count</b> ...
<p><b>What will my child be learning?</b></p>	<p>I can join in with my favourite stories and guess what will happen next.</p> <p>I know that stories have beginnings and endings and sometimes I guess how the story will end.</p> <p>I can listen to longer stories and talk about them.</p> <p>I can talk about the places and people in stories and the important things that are happening.</p> <p>I like to look at the pictures and words in books. I can show you words when we are outdoors.</p>	<p>I can use all sorts of building toys and empty cardboard boxes to make things.</p> <p>I make lines and piles of blocks, joining the pieces together to make things like houses and car parks.</p> <p>I know that I can use tools like scissors, spoons and hammers to do different things.</p>	<p>I can sing some familiar songs.</p> <p>I like joining in with dancing and ring games.</p> <p>I am beginning to move with rhythm, especially when I hear music I like.</p>	<p>I can use some number names and words like "more than" and "fewer than", when I am playing.</p> <p>I can say numbers in order from 1 to 10.</p> <p>I know that numbers tell me how many things there are altogether, like 8 biscuits on a plate.</p> <p>I can show interest in shapes by sustained construction activity or by talking about shapes or arrangements.</p> <p>I can show interest in shapes in the environment.</p>
<p><b>Magic Maths Monday</b></p>	<p>Read Goldilocks and the Three Bears. You could organise your toys, bowls, spoons etc. Start with the largest item first and work your way down.</p>

Have a go at some Caterpillar art. Could you print a caterpillar shape using empty toilet rolls? Or handprints? Or you could even make a paper chain.



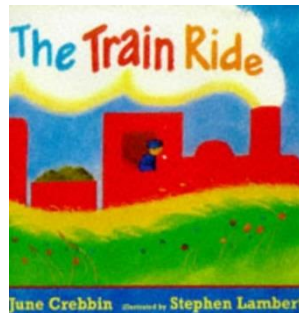
Sing a selection of your child's favourite nursery rhymes. Are there any household objects you could use as props?

Read The Train Ride by June Crebbin. The children have read this recently so should be familiar and could have a go at retelling the story.

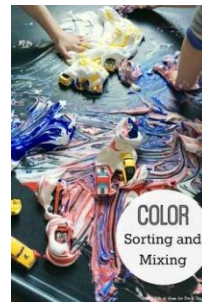

Sing The Wheels on the Bus.



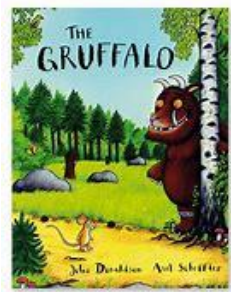
Use your number flash cards to play 'number thief'. Can you spot the missing number? Take turns and remember to close your eyes!

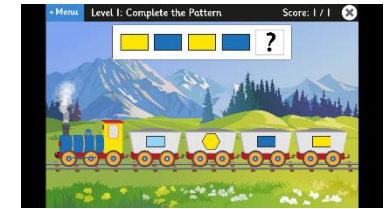


To celebrate WBD, have a go at some baking today. You could make Gruffalo crumble or Gruffalo claws. There are lots of lovely easy recipes on pinterest.

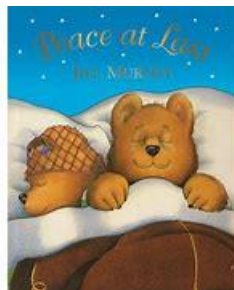
