$$12 + 3 =$$

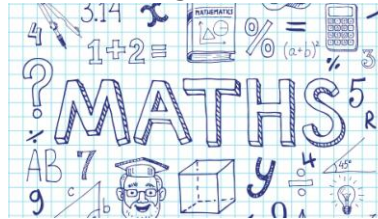
$$20 + 6 =$$
