Challenge 1

Maths -

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A pizza shop makes 176 pizza bases before opening. Over the evening they will sell 247 pizzas. During the evening, they make another 80 pizza bases. How many pizza bases will be left at the end of the evening?

Bailey says they have 151 pizza bases left. Ashleigh says they have 9 pizza bases left.

Who is correct and what mistakes have been made? What other errors might be made?



Challenge 2

Research a famous person born in Newcastle and produce an information page about them. You could also draw a portrait of them. Try to include why they are famous in your information page.



Challenge 3

Design a new mascot for Newcastle United. You should colour your mascot and give it a name. Explain why you have chosen this design.



Challenge 4

Create your own word search about Newcastle. The theme could be famous sights, Newcastle United players or even areas in the city such as Newbiggin Hall and Westerhope!



Challenge 7


