#### **Attendance**

We are very concerned about the low level of attendance across school. Our overall percentage is well below national average. Every day matters in school and if your children are not in then they are not learning. Low attendance will impact on your children's achievement.

Today we had 24 children arriving late to school. We need to instil in all our children that school matters and we should not be late! Children don't like walking into lessons or assembly that have already started. Please help us to improve this. We will be monitoring lateness on the yard next week and rewarding those who always arrive on time.

## Nursery full time provision for all!

We are delighted to be able to offer 30 hours free education for all children age 3 or above. Currently nursery children can access 15 hours or 30 hours if they are entitled or pay. We have now decided to offer this to everyone and we will not be charging. This will start from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> June.

So that means 75 extra hours of free education! Our only catch is that to keep your place in Nursery your child must have 96% attendance or above. If attendance drops, without every good reasons, then your extra hours will be given to the next person on the waiting list.

Children can now start our Nursery as soon as they turn three years old.

Please see the office for application forms and to put your names down. Places are limited so if you would like to take up this offer please let us know asap.
