

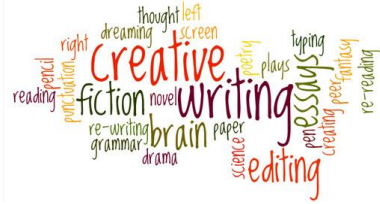
Year 3 4 Weekly Homework (Week commencing Monday 30th March)
