Draw or make a 2D shape monster. Can you label how many sides and corners each shape has?

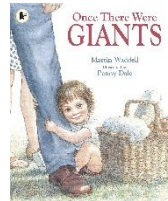

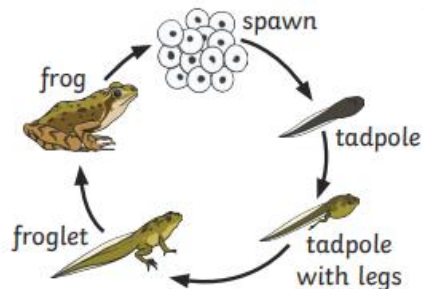
