#### Challenge 1: History

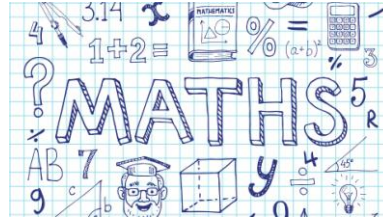


A game which used to be played a long time ago was marbles.

Then can you write down the rules of the game for a friend to read and play with you.

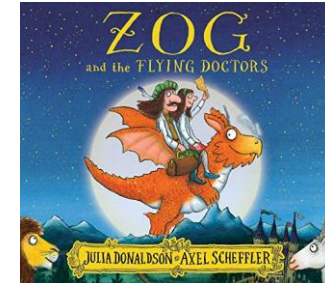
#### Challenge 2: Maths

#### Challenge 4: PSHE

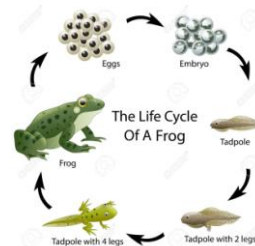


You have probably heard about Captain Tom Moore raising lots of money for the NHS
