

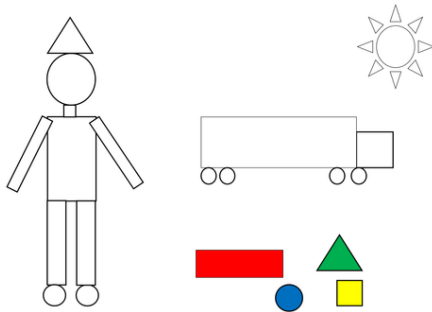
Year 1 Weekly Homework

<p><u>Challenge 4: Maths 2</u></p> <p>Go on a 2D and 3D shape hunt around your house and write a list of the shapes you have found.</p> <p>Look out for:</p> <p>2D: oblong (rectangle), triangle, square, circle</p> <p>3D: sphere, cuboid, cube, cylinder, cone</p>	<p><u>Challenge 5: Science</u></p> <p>Design and then make a container to hold an egg to stop the egg from smashing when dropped from a height. Do the experiment once the container is made.</p> <p>Evaluate your container. What would you do differently? What worked well? Which other materials could you use to protect the egg?</p>	<p><u>Challenge 6: Art/DT</u></p> <p>Make a piece of art which reflects the word 'home'. You can use any media you wish; drawing, painting, printmaking, sculpture, collage or video.</p> <p>Send a photo of your work alongside your name and age to north_east_art@outlook.com for a competition! 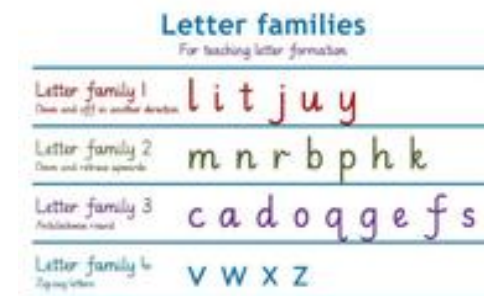
Challenge 8: Phonics/Reading
