Hi everyone,

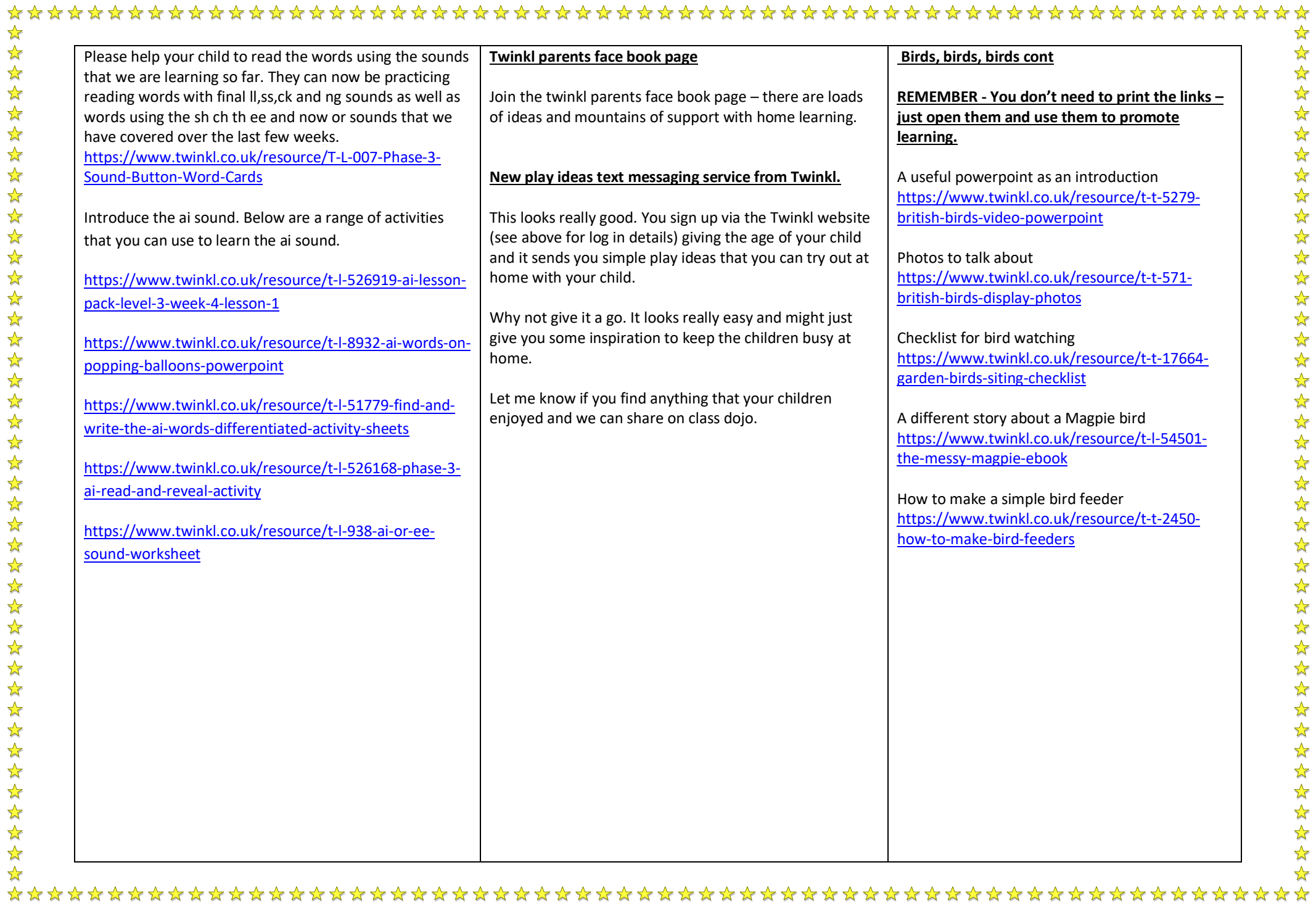

Please help your child to read the words using the sounds that we are learning so far. They can now be practicing reading words with final ll,ss,ck and ng sounds as well as words using the sh ch th ee and now or sounds that we have covered over the last few weeks.
