Challenge 1: History



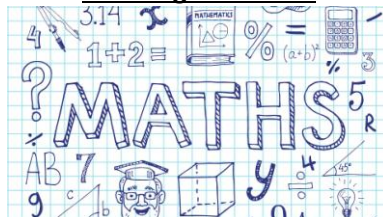
A game which used to be played a long time ago was hand clapping games.

Can you research any more hand clapping games. You could have a go at learning these songs, ask a grown up to video you singing the song and attach it to your portfolio on Class Dojo.

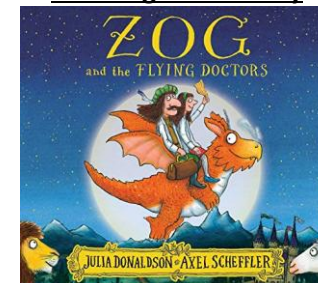
Challenge 2: Maths

The video on Class Dojo may be posted in 2 separate parts so make sure you watch both videos and pause the video where needed.

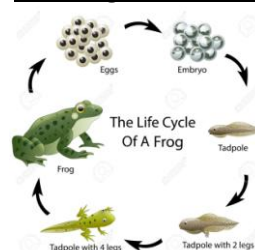
Challenge 4: PSHE

It is made up of green for land and blue for the sea. A large bit of green (land) on a globe/map is called a continent.

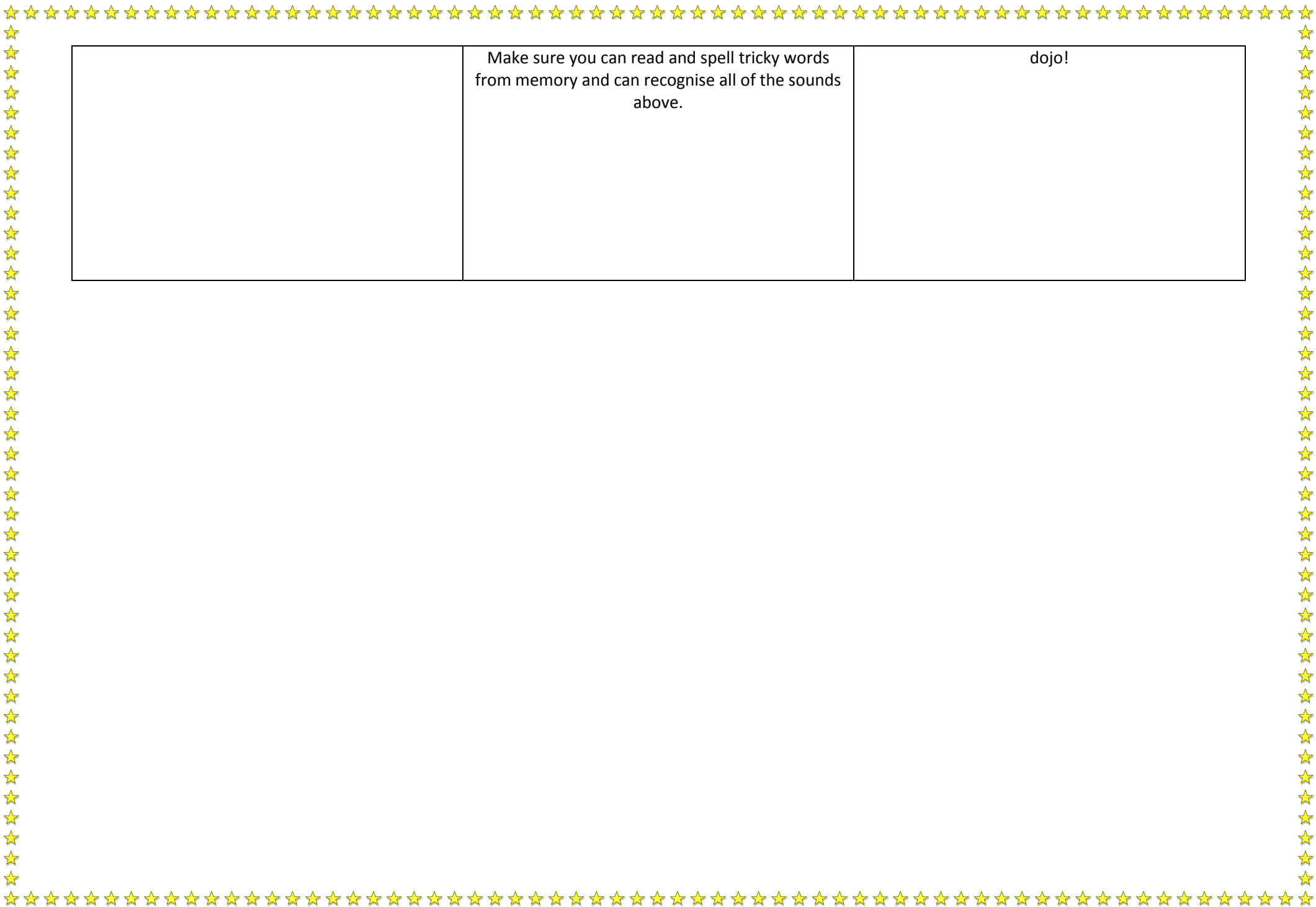
Earth has 7 continents.
